RULES

Application is open to soloists (strings, woodwinds, brass, piano, guitar, harp) and groups of all nationalities under the age of 25.

Announcement of results of the preliminary round: 3 May Final in person: May 15th at the Teatro Sociale in Como

- SECTIONS AND CATEGORIES

SECT. 1 SOLOISTS

Instrument: - piano

- strings

- woodwinds and brass

- string instruments (guitar and harp)

SECT. 2 DUOS

SECT. 3 TRIOS TO QUINTETS

Junior Category: 6 to 9 years of age (except those who turned 10) **Young Category**: 10 to 13 years of age (except those who turned 14) **A Category**: 14 to 18 years of age (except those who turned 19) **B Category**: 19 to 25 years of age (excluding those who turned 26)

Age at the time of the registration deadline is considered.

For sections 2 and 3, the oldest member is considered.

Those who wish will have the opportunity to enroll in a category higher than their age, but not in a lower one.

- PROGRAM AND DURATION

The program is free for the participants to choose.

SECTION 1

Yunior Category: up to 8 minutes **Young Category**: up to 10 minutes **A Category**: up to 15 minutes **B Category**: up to 20 minutes

SECTIONS 2, 3

Young Category: up to 10 minutes **Young Category**: up to 10 minutes **A Category**: up to 20 minutes **B Category**: up to 25 minutes

- PERFORMANCES

The competition includes an online preliminary round and a final in person.

Participants must video-record the chosen repertoire: the footage must be shot by a still camera and must include the performer and his/her hands on the instrument.

If necessary, soloists can play with the accompaniment of another instrument or over a pre-recorded track.

The video must then be uploaded to a YOUTUBE channel, making it visible only to those in possession of the link (use the "unlisted" setting).

The video title must include: Concorso Esperia, name (of the soloist or group), section, instrument (in the case of soloists) and category.

Participants of categories A and B who will be "absolute winners" of the respective sections and instrumental specialties (they can belong to either category) will be required to perform in the final in which the prizes will be awarded. The final will be held on May 15, 2022 in the presence of the jury and the public, at the Teatro Sociale in Como in compliance with the rules relating to the health emergency.

The program of the final may be different from that of the online preliminary round. The artistic directors reserve the right to postpone the final in case of problems caused by the epidemiological situation and the relative legislation in force.

- RANKINGS AND PRIZES

1st absolute prize, 99 and 100 points: diploma and medal

1st prize, 95 to 98 points: first prize diploma **2nd prize 90 to 94 points**: second prize diploma **3rd prize 85 to 89 points**: third prize diploma

Scores lower than 85 points: certificate of attendance

PRIZE FOR THE ABSOLUTE FIRST WINNER (Categories A and B):

- SECTION 1: 1'000 EUROS AND 2 PRIZE CONCERTS

- SECTIONS 2 and 3: 2'000 EUROS AND 2 PRIZE CONCERTS

The jury reserves the right not to award prizes if it deems no candidate worthy.

The results of the preliminary round will be announced within May 3rd through publication on the www.lakecomoart.it website. The score of the absolute first of categories A and B will not be published as they will be invited to perform in person at the final (in compliance with the regulations relating to health emergencies).
